Councilman Johnson moved to approve the canvass of returns and declared Freddie Taylor the winner of Place 4 with a majority vote of 71.73% and Emily Glass the winner of Place 5 with a majority vote of 67.32%. Councilman Sellers seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.
